
The **School of Philosophy** of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens presents a

Byzantine Aesthetics is one of the most distinctive periods in the History of Art with its own, very particular style, immediately discernible and which exerted a major influence on the evolution of artistic expression and aesthetics.

This intensive course explores fundamental aspects of the world of Byzantine art such as Byzantine Philosophical Aesthetics, Byzantine Painting and Byzantine Music.



Workshops will allow students to gain an in-depth understanding of the theory and practices of Byzantine Art and the distinctive Byzantine style

Program Structure: The program includes daily course class sessions, smaller discussion sections and other activities that will allow participants to delve into Greece's Byzantine artistic and cultural heritage.

Venue: School of Philosophy, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, Greece.

Date: July 01 - July 10, 2025.

Course Format and Length: In-Person, 9 days, programmed courses plus examination.

Cost: 900€

(a deposit of 300 euros is mandatory upon acceptance)

The program fee includes:

Applicants will be accepted on academic criteria and order of application.

Accreditation: On completion of the course, each student will receive academic credits and a certificate of attendance.

The program accredits 3 ECTS (75 hours of study)
